NERA F77 - TELEPHONE DISTRESS CALL



TRANSMISSION

- 1 Lift flap over **DISTRESS** BUTTON.
- 2 Press and hold down **DISTRESS BUTTON for** at least 6 seconds.
- **3** Press (#A-a).on the handset, or wait 15 seconds to initiate distress automatically. The handset display reads:
- **4** When the Rescue Coordination Centre (RCC) Operator answers, speak clearly, and give the following message:



DISTRESS ALARM BU77FR BUTTON



- MAYDAY MAYDAY MAYDAY
- THIS IS (ship's name and identity) CALLING ON INMARSAT FROM **POSITION** (latitude and longitude, or relative to a point of land).
- MY INMARSAT MOBILE NUMBER IS (IMN for the Nera F77 telephone you are calling from) USING THE (Ocean Region) SATELLITE.
- MY COURSE AND SPEED ARE (course and speed).
- NATURE OF YOUR DISTRESS, for example:
 - > Fire/explosion > Listing > Flooding

 - > Sinking
 - > Collision > Grounding
- and adrift
- > Abandoning ship
- > Piracv attack
- > Disabled > Medical service required
- ASSISTANCE YOU REQUIRE.
- OTHER INFORMATION to help rescue units.

End your message by saying "OVER", which is the invitation for the RCC to reply.

- **5** Follow the instructions from the RCC Operator, and when requested, replace the handset in the cradle to await further calls.
- **6** Keep the telephone line clear so that the RCC can call you back when necessary.

RECEPTION

- The ALARM BUZZER is activated when a distress call is received.
- When answering the call by pressing , the ALARM BUZZER stops. The handset displays **Incoming DISTRESS**.
- Note down and follow the instructions from the caller.
